<b>First Reading:</b>	A reading from the Book of Deuteronomy (8: 2 - 3, 14 - 16) <i>He fed you with manna which neither you nor your fathers had known.</i>
<b>Psalm:</b>	Psalm 147: 12 - 15, 19 - 20 <b>O praise the Lord, Jerusalem!</b>
<b>Second Reading:</b>	A reading from the first letter of St Paul to the Corinthians( 10: 16 - 17) <i>That there is only one loaf means that, though there are many of us, we form a single body.</i>
<b>Gospel Acclamation:</b>	<b>Alleluia, alleluia! I am the living bread which has come down from heaven, says the Lord. Anyone who eats the bread will live forever. Alleluia!</b>
