## A NEW YEAR: THE YEAR OF THE WORD

This Sunday marks a new liturgical year and the beginning of the season of Advent. Over the course of three years we read Matthew, Mark, and Luke. We will now hear from the Gospel according to Matthew at the Masses over the months ahead. The *Wednesday Word* sheets can help us prepare for the Mass by anticipating the Sunday readings, meaning that we can be more receptive to the Word of God and the words of the priest who, in his homily, will try to speak to the sacred Scriptures. The Bishops of England and Wales have invited the whole Church to keep a *Year of the Word* in 2019-2020 to renew our love for and knowledge of the Word of God, the Bible. This Sunday we have a Pastoral Letter from Bishop Mark wherein the Year of the Word entitled *The God Who Speaks* will be more fully explored. As Advent begins, heralding the coming of our Lord, let every heart prepare him room.

For the time being at the Cathedral, we will have Holy Communion under one kind, the Host, pending the disruption of the building works and the reduced number of Extraordinary Ministers. We can use this 'pause' as a chance to renew our sense of reverence for Holy Communion, and I will speak about the gift we are given by Our Lord in His Precious Body and Blood.

Additional Evening Masses at the Cathedral: I am considering having two evening Masses following Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament during the week at the Cathedral at 6.15pm to allow people to attend Mass who may not ordinarily be able to get to Mass in the day because of work or other commitments. If this would be welcomed or appreciated, please do let me know.
