Sacrament of The Sick

In our care of the sick and housebound of the parish, sometimes there can be an anxiety that a priest is not able to come when someone is very poorly or very close to death. If someone is sick, housebound, frail or about to undergo a serious operation, it is encouraged that the person ask the priest for the sacrament of the sick, and that they go to confession and receive anointing as soon as possible. This allows some of the anxiety that friends and relatives, and the sick person themselves, might feel under when illness worsens and can reassure them that they've received the sacraments of the church and be sure of God's presence with them.
