Mass Time Change Effective 15th September: Effective Sunday 15th September, the 12.15pm Extra-Ordinary Form Mass will change to 11.15am. This change, made by the Bishop in discussion with Fr Edmund and Canon Smith, is necessary to allow the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest (ICKSP) to make themselves available for their growing apostolate in England and to ensure that, if necessary, Canon Smith could offer an additional Mass elsewhere. Representations have been made aware that this new Mass time may cause some logistical issues regarding tea and coffee following the 9.30am Mass. It is not unusual for a church to have two morning Masses on a Sunday and it is hoped that this new time will not have a deleterious effect on either the Ordinary Form Mass or the Extra-Ordinary Form Mass congregations.
