Lent 2019

Ash Wednesday this week is a day of fasting and abstinence in the Church and marks the beginning of the holy season of Lent. Confessions are available in the Cathedral from 11.30am to 12noon and from 5pm to 6pm.

Stations of the Cross – In the Cathedral during Lent: Fridays at 11.30am & Sundays after the 8.30am Mass. The way of the cross with biblical texts and reflections lasts about 35 minutes.
